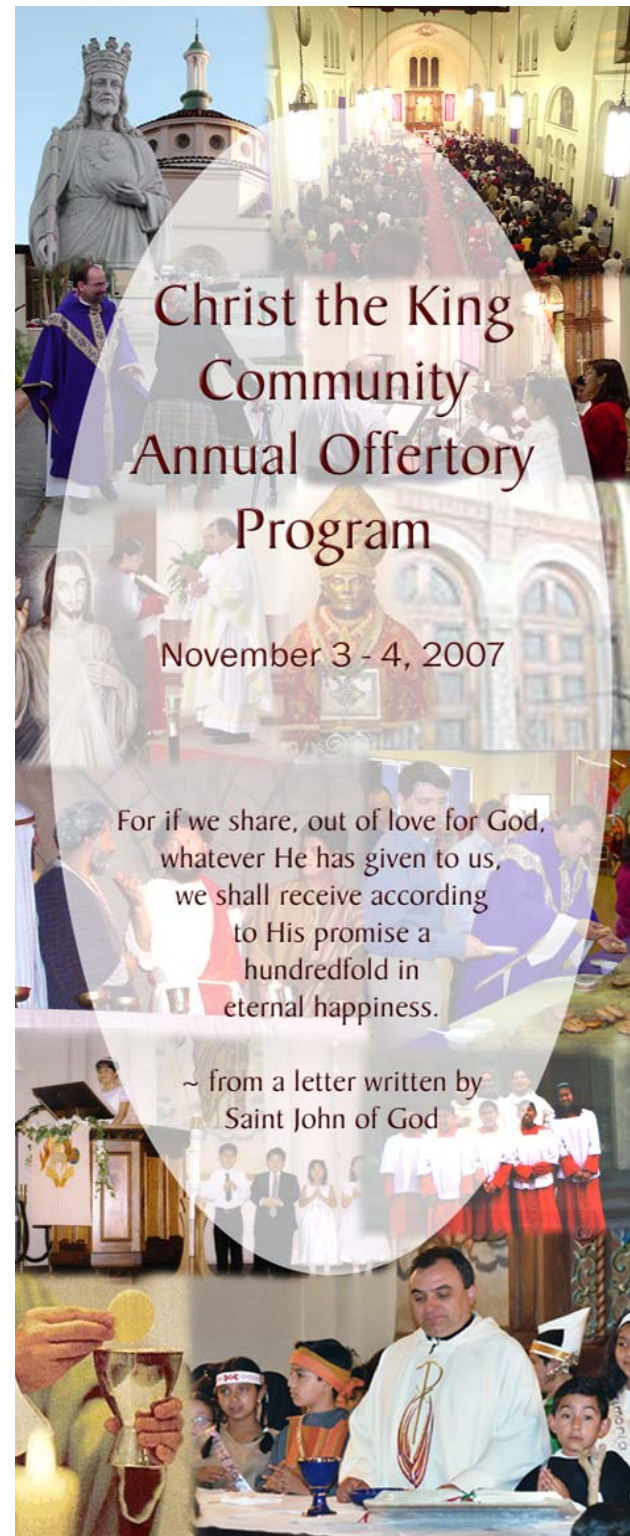

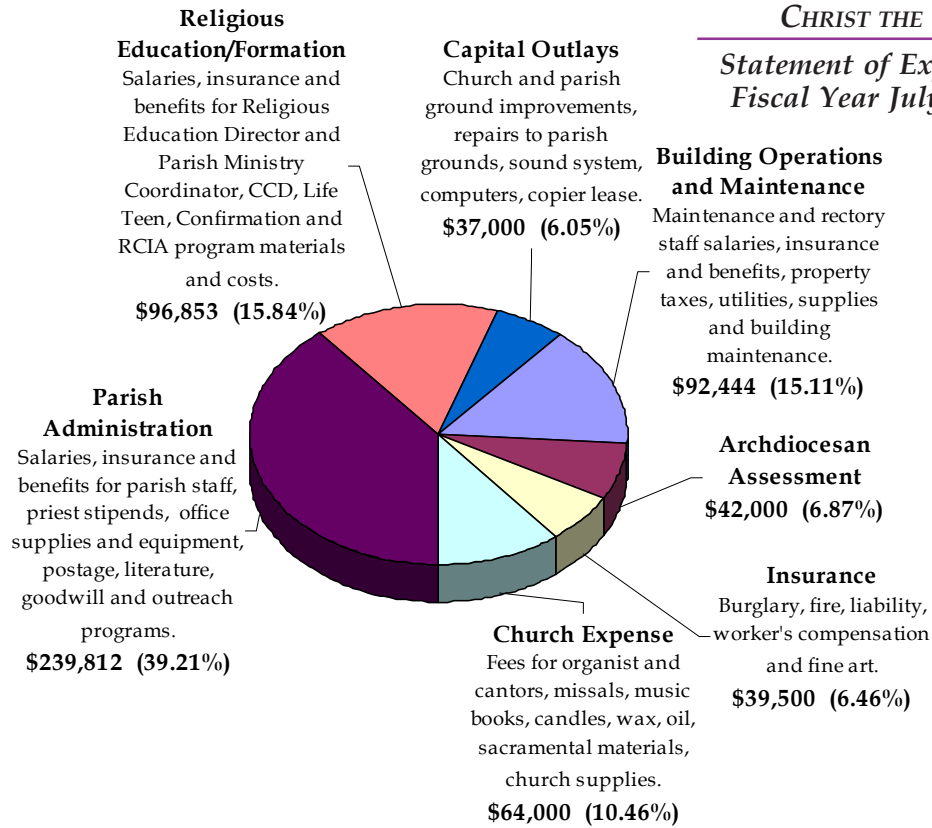
Thank you for lovingly contributing to the life of our parish. Let us all help continue to make Christ the King Parish known for its faith, generosity, and deep caring for one another.
